We are looking forward to another wonderful school year! Below is the list of supplies students will need for their 2018-2019 classes. **Please have these supplies by the first day of school, Tuesday, August 7<sup>th</sup>.** Students should label items with their name or initials when possible. Check with your student throughout the year to replenish materials as needed. Pre-K and Kindergarten school supplies, including crayons, glue, paint sets, pencils, erasers, scissors, art boxes, writing paper, etc. will be ordered by the school for each child. They only need to provide nap mats and earbuds or headphones.

Kid-Safe headphones that regulate volume are available locally at Walmart, Target, Best Buy and Toys 'R Us. There are several brands that range in price from \$15.00 to \$20.00.

We politely request that you do not send expensive, high-end headphones such as Bose and Beats by Dre.
